


Installing SAS JMP Pro 13 on a Personal PC.



This document discusses how to install SAS JMP Pro 13 on a PC.

1. Run the installer file downloaded from the University as an administrator. This will install SAS JMP on your computer, just like a normal program.
2. When you get to the Installation Options, click next (unless you want a different language pack installed) as the program defaults to the most tailored package for your current configuration.
3. When installation has completed, run SASJMP 13.
4. The program will prompt you for a key. The key is located in the name of your user profile's document folder in the JMP13License directory (example, c:\users\Joe\Documents\JMP13License).



5. Please note, if your Administrator account is different than the User account, the Document will be extracted in the Administrator folder.
6. If successful, the program will ask for Select the key file in the correct directory and install. The program doesn't need this information and you can just click OK.



7. The next screen will request a location to keep your SAS key. Where you put it is up to you. May I suggest putting it in the C:\Program Files\SAS\ directory.
8. The next screen will prompt you to register the program. Again, this is up to the user to select, as either option does not impact functionality.



9. SAS JMP 13 is now installed.
